Maintain cleanliness at all times.</li><li>3. Remove the fluid bag from the overpouch.</li><li>4. Snap off the tip of the needle connector at the end of the delivery tube ensuring the solution can flow freely and connect the sterile needle provided.</li><li>5. Disinfect the injection site and insert the needle.</li><li>6. Subcutaneous injection should be given under the skin of the neck or over the ribs. To assist the flow of the injection, gently squeeze the bag to inject the contents.</li><li>7. Large volumes should be distributed over more than one injection site.</li><li>8.
